The Town of Exeter is planning to remove the Great Dam on the Exeter River. As part of the ongoing design and permitting of the project, the Town of Exeter and its partners, which includes the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, are working to define the potential effects on historic resources that may result from the dam's removal, as well as how to mitigate those potential effects.

To ensure public input during this planning, the Town is holding this meeting to comply with Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act. The Town is asking for your input on impacts to historic resources as a result of dam's removal and suggested mitigation measures.
