

## BOSTON FLOWER AND GARDEN SPRING FLOWER SHOW WEDNESDAY, MARCH 16, 2016 & FRIDAY, MARCH 18, 2016



**EVENT:** The Boston Flower & Garden Show returns to the Seaport World Trade Center in Boston on Wednesday, March 16, 2016 through Sunday, March 20, 2016 with the theme – *Natured by Nature*. **DEADLINE:** The deadline to register is Friday, February 26, 2016, or once the van is filled. **Note:** We need a minimum of 8 people registered. Max of 13 people.

The staff will relay to the trip escort that he/she needs to be sure you get the necessary seat. **Parents** are expected to have complete control of their children at all times throughout the trip.
