&
Zimmerman House**
Wednesday, May 11th, 2016



EVENT: Join us as we travel to Manchester, NH to explore the Currier Museum of Art and the Zimmerman House. The **Currier Museum of Art** features European and American paintings, decorative arts, photographs, and sculptures. The permanent collection includes work from Picasso, Matisse, Monet, Frank Lloyd Wright, and Andrew Wyeth. During our visit to the museum, we will also have access to the special exhibit *Killer Heels: The Art of the High-Heeled Shoe*. Following our visit to the museum, we will also have a private tour of **The Zimmerman House**. The Zimmerman House was designed by one of the world's greatest modern architects, Frank Lloyd Wright. Wright designed the house, the interiors, all the furniture, the gardens and even the mailbox. In 1979 the building was listed in the National Register of Historic Places. The Zimmerman House is a work of art, and the only Wright house open to the public in New England.

Lunch is on your own at the Winter Garden Café (on site). The Winter Garden Café is the perfect spot to refuel during our visit to the museum, with hearty soups, sandwiches, and desserts.

DATE: The date selected is Wednesday, May 11, 2016. We will depart the Exeter Recreation Center parking lot at 10:15am and will be returning to Exeter approximately 4:00pm.

COST: The cost of the tour includes admission to the Currier Museum of Art, Zimmerman House, and transportation in the Recreation Department Van.
