Tour of Lexington and Concord



Wednesday, August 17th, 2016

EVENT: Living in New England, we are fortunate enough to be surrounded by so much history. Join us as we travel back in time on our own private tour with our very own Patriot tour guide. On our tour of Lexington and Concord, we will visit the birthplaces of American liberty and 19th Century literature. We will ride along the historic Battle Road while our costumed guide recounts the exciting events of April 19th, 1775 and the literary legacy that defined American identity and culture. Along our tour, we will see the Lexington Battle Green, Buckman Tavern, the Hancock-Clarke House, Munroe Tavern, Orchard House, and many more historic sites!

Note: This is a private tour. We will have our own guide on our own van, so the front seat will be reserved for the tour guide.

DATE: The date selected is Wednesday, August 17th, 2016. We will depart the Exeter Recreation Center parking lot at 8:30am and will be returning to Exeter approximately 4:30pm.
