<u>PROGRAM</u>: Our Mighty Macs ski and snowboard programs are designed for the skier or snowboarder of any level. All students are grouped according to age & ability. LESSONS:

Level 1:Gliding Wedge-Never skied before. Can stand, walk, climb & glide. Can do gliding wedge, slow down & stop.

Level 2:Wedge Turns-Can ride the long wonder carpet & make controlled linked wedge turns to the bottom. Can make controlled linked wedge turns & make spontaneous wide & narrow turns. Can make spontaneous turns & come to a complete stop by turning in either direction. Can ride the chair & also do the above.

Level 3:Wedge Christies-Have begun working on reducing the size of your wedge turns. Can start all your turns in a wedge & bring your skies to a match at the end of each turn.

Level 4:Advanced Wedge Christies-Have begun working on advanced wedge Christies(bring your skis together early in the turn). Can wedge your skis slightly at the beginning of each turn but bring them together very early in the turn. Can ski moderately & beginning to use your inside pole as a timing & steadying device.

Level 5:Open parallel-Have begun to work on keeping my skis parallel without a wedge. Can change the edges of your skis at the same time without a wedge. Can use a pole touch to time & steady your turns.

Level 6:Dynamic Parallel-Can us your whole body towards the new turns to change directions. Can swing & touch your pole to the snow to start each turn. Can link parallel turns continuously.

Level 7:Short Radius Turns-Have begun to work on short radius turns. Can do short radius turns & your lower body & torso face downhill continuously. Can do short radius turns & block each turn with a solid pole plant.

Level 8:Carved Turns-Can roll onto an early edge & hold the edge throughout the entire turn, leaving a narrow track in the snow. Can also skid to control your speed. Can ski any & all terrain, ice, moguls, steeps & race courses.

LOCATION/ HOW TO GET THERE: McIntyre Ski Area - 50 Chalet Ct. Manchester, NH 03104

From Portsmouth, NH:

- Take Route 101 West toward Manchester
- Take the exit onto I-93 North toward Concord
- Take Exit 8 for Wellington Rd/Bridge St.
- Right off the exit onto Wellington Rd.
- Turn right onto Mammoth Rd.
- Turn left onto Kennard Rd.
- McIntyre will be on your left on Chalet Ct.
- Travel time: ~ 48 minutes

From Keene, NH:

- NH-10 N/NH-9 E/Franklin Pierce Hwy
- Continue to follow NH-9 E/Franklin Pierce Hwy
- Take the ramp onto I-89 S
- Take the exit onto I-93 S toward Manchester/Boston
- Slight right to stay on I-93 S
- Take Exit 8 for Wellington Rd/Bridge St.
- Right off the exit onto Wellington Rd.
- Turn right onto Mammoth Rd.
- Turn left onto Kennard Rd.
- McIntyre will be on your left on Chalet Ct.
- Travel time: ~ 1 hour 12 minutes
