The M/S Mount Washington is the flagship vessel cruising beautiful Lake Winnipesaukee daily during peak season. This beautiful ship has been cruising the lake since her inaugural voyage on August 15th, 1940. On our cruise, we will depart from Weirs Beach and follow the western shore of the lake, passing Glendale, West Alton, and Rattlesnake Island before docking in Wolfeboro. We will follow a slightly different route back to Weirs Beach on our 2.5 hour scenic cruise. With four decks of space to sprawl out on (indoor and outdoor), you are sure to find a great spot to view the beautiful coastline and vacation homes.

Lunch is included in your registration fee. Following our scenic cruise, we will be stopping at Fratello's Italian Grille in Laconia, NH. Fratello's features Italian dishes with American flare! There is something here for everyone to enjoy.

<u>DATE</u>: The date selected is Wednesday, July 19, 2017. We will depart the Exeter Recreation Center parking lot at 8:00am and will be returning to Exeter at approximately 3:30pm.
