



**“RED SOX vs. YANKEES”
BUS TRIP TO YANKEE STADIUM**

EVENT: The Boston Red Sox and the NY Yankees share one of the greatest traditions and rivalries known to sport. “The Home That Ruth Built” may be gone but its memory lives on in the new Yankee Stadium. The new Yankee Stadium opened in the spring of 2009.

DATES & TIMES: The date selected is SATURDAY, June 28th, 2014. Game time is at 7:00pm. We will be departing at two locations: **Seacoast Media Group 111 New Hampshire Avenue, Portsmouth NH** and **Hampton Park and Ride Timber Swamp Rd, Hampton NH** at 11:00AM. We'll arrive at Yankee Stadium prior to the game, which will allow you to see warm ups, or visit Monument Park. You'll enjoy all the action from your reserved seats. After the game you'll depart the stadium and return to Portsmouth approximately at 3:00am (Time subject to game outcome). The bus may make 2 stops for your convenience:

COST: The cost of this trip includes coach transportation and driver gratuity, Tickets to game, and a Tailgate Party before the game with hamburgers and hot dogs being offered.

BUS GUIDELINES: Registrants must sit in the same seat(s) on the bus on the return trip as they sat in on the first part of the trip. If you have a need requiring you to sit in a particular area of the bus, please let the Recreation Office know when you register for the trip. The staff will relay to the trip escort that he/she needs to be sure you get the necessary seat on the bus. **Please note:** For courtesy sake and physical needs of certain passengers; you are allowed to save your own seat and one other. **Parents** are expected to have complete control of their children at all times throughout the trip. An escort will only intervene if he/she feels a parent doesn't have/are not adequately controlling/disciplining their child(ren); especially if other passengers/participants are affected.

Exeter Parks & Recreation Department sponsored bus trips are designed to provide members of the Exeter Community - families, friends, and individuals alike - with safe, relaxing and enjoyable sports and entertainment experiences. To ensure these goals, the Exeter Parks and Recreation Department has established a policy of prohibiting the possession and use of alcohol and other drugs while on board trip buses.
