




**Sam Adams Brewery Tour

EVENT: The Exeter Parks & Recreation Department invites you to join us for a trip to Boston for a tour of the Samuel Adams Brewery and lunch at Doyle's Café. Guests on this trip will learn all about Samuel Adams, American brewer and patriot, experience the entire craft brewing process, taste the special malts and smell the Hallertau hops used to brew *Samuel Adams*[®], and, of course, sample a few of their award winning beers. Following the tour, we will head over to Doyle's Café, the first bar to serve Samuel Adams beer on tap.

DATE: The date selected is Thursday, November 21st, 2013. We will depart the Exeter Recreation Center parking lot at 9:00am and will be returning to Exeter approximately 3:30pm.

COST: The cost of the tour includes the Samuel Adams Brewery tour and transportation in the Recreation Department's van.

Lunch for this trip is at Doyle's Café. Doyle's Café, the bar to first serve Sam Adams beer on tap features a huge menu of appetizers, entrees, soups, sandwiches and more! There's sure to be something on the menu for everyone's taste.

DEADLINE: The deadline to register is Friday, November 8, 2013, or once the van is sold out.
