WARRANT ARTICLES

Warrant Article #1: Operating Budget

Shall the Exeter School District vote to raise and appropriate as an operating budget, not including appropriations by special warrant articles and other appropriations voted separately, the amounts set forth on the budget posted with the warrant and as amended by vote of the first session, for the purposes set forth therein, totaling \$25,769,231? Should this article be defeated, the default budget shall be \$25,711,928, which is the same as last year, with certain adjustments required by previous action of the Exeter School District or by law; or the governing body may hold one special meeting, in accordance with RSA 40:13, X and XVI, to take up the issue of a revised operating budget only. The School Board recommends \$25,769,231. (Majority vote required)

Warrant Article #2: Collective Bargaining Agreement

Shall the Exeter School District vote to approve the cost items included in the collective bargaining agreement reached between the Exeter School District and the Exeter Paraprofessional Association which calls for the following increases in salaries and benefits at the current staffing level over those paid in a prior fiscal year:

Fiscal Year	Estimated Increase
2026	\$356,149
2027	\$286,233
2028	\$170,759

and further to raise and appropriate \$356,149 for the 2025-2026 fiscal year, such sum representing the additional costs attributable to the increase in salaries and benefits required by the new agreement over those that would be paid at current staffing levels. The School Board recommends that the School District approve these cost items and make the appropriation of \$356,149. (Majority vote required)

Warrant Article #3: Special Education Expendable Trust
