Town of Exeter, NH Mosquito Adulticide Applications Scheduled for 8/20/2024

Due to the elevated risk of exposure to Eastern Equine Encephalitis (EEE) in local mosquito and bird populations, adulticide treatments have been scheduled to protect residents in Exeter and surrounding areas. On August 20th, 2024 crews from Northeast Vegetation and Mosquito Control will conduct adulticide mosquito control treatments in parks, schools, and athletic fields. Perimeter woodlines will be treated to repel adult mosquitoes from areas of public gathering. Only trees and brush areas will be treated; no flowering vegetation is treated to protect pollinators. The adulticide used, Crosscheck +, contains the active ingredient bifenthrin, and is dry within 1 hour. Treatment provides mosquito control for 3-4 weeks in areas of likely exposure to mosquitoes.

Treatment sites include:

Exeter High School Complex

Main Street Elementary

Lincoln Street Elementary

Park St Common

Exeter Recreation Park

Memorial Skate Park

YMCA/SST Facilities

Winter Street Park

Brickyard Park

And Downtown Recreation Center/Fire Department

Treatment will proceed throughout the day, signs will be left at all areas treated with time of treatment and reentry time. This has been determined by surveillance data, and in consultation with Town officials and NH DHHS. This notice shall serve as 24 hour notice as required by law.
