PROGRAM: The Exeter Parks & Recreation Department is pleased to offer our Pee-Wee Lacrosse Program for student's ages 5 - 8. This non-contact program will introduce the basic lacrosse skills. Emphasis will be on catching, throwing, cradling, and ground balls. Sessions will include skill instruction and fun activities that emphasize previously learned skills.

INSTRUCTOR: Exeter Youth Lacrosse will instruct this program with the assistance of student and parent volunteers. If you are interested in volunteering for this program please contact the office and complete volunteer form & background check form. No prior experience is necessary.

REGISTRATION: Registration begins **Monday**, **February 18**, **2025**. Registrations are open to Exeter and surrounding towns, on a first-come, first-served basis. Registrations accepted at the Exeter Recreation Office during our business hours, in-person, online, by phone or mail. Payment must be paid at the time of registration. Registration is limited to 50 players.

LOCATION: The program will be held at Tuck Learning Field, Linden St. Exeter.

EQUIPMENT: A Lacrosse stick & ball provided. Gloves, Goggles and any additional equipment are optional.

<u>FEE:</u> Registration Fee includes the above equipment that is provided and a T-shirt. (Program cost is not adjusted if dates of program are adjusted due to field conditions).
