



# Titanic: The Artifact Exhibition

**EVENT:** Join EPRD as we travel down to Boston, Massachusetts to step back in time and visit the Titanic. Embark on an interactive tour of the Titanic with incredible re-creations of the ship's interior and exterior. Visitors receive a replica boarding pass, assume the role of a passenger, and follow a chronological journey through life on Titanic. Walk the halls, explore the galleries, peer into cabins, and meet passengers and crew throughout the voyage. The 15,000-square-foot Exhibition features replica interior rooms and a full-scale re-creation of the Grand Staircase. Visitors will be able to view authentic artifacts, respectfully recovered from two and a half miles below surface of the North Atlantic, which tell the real story behind Titanic's journey from construction to eventual recovery. After the exhibit, we will enjoy lunch at Red's Kitchen and Tavern.

**DATE:** The date selected is Thursday, November 21st, 2024. We will depart the Exeter Recreation Center parking lot at 8:45am and will be returning to Exeter at approximately 4:00pm

**FEE:** The fee is **\$60.00 for residents and \$80.00 for non-residents**, which includes entrance to the museum, lunch, and transportation in the Recreation Department's van.

**DEADLINE:** The deadline to register is Friday, November 15th, 2024, or once the van is sold out.

**Note: We need a minimum of 8 people registered for this trip. Maximum is 12.**

**REFUNDS:** No refunds after tickets/reservations have been purchased unless we can find a replacement for your spot in the program.\*

\*Medical Injury/Illness Policy: If there is a medically documented injury/illness we will prorate a refund after we receive written medical varication from your physician which must be received prior to the trip.

**Accessibility Guidelines:** The EPRD van is not wheelchair accessible. While we are able to accommodate a range of mobility levels, all participants must be able to step up into the van and step out of the van on their own without assistance. All trips will be rated for accessibility. Please refer to the top of the flyer for the accessibility rating to determine if this trip matches your level of comfort with walking, stairs, and uneven ground.
