EVENT: On this trip, you will ride up beautiful Mount Washington on the Cog Railway and experience beautiful fall foliage. The Cog Railway offers scenic train rides to the Summit of Mount Washington, the highest peak in the Northeast, on the World's First Mountain Climbing Cog Railway Train! Located in Scenic Bretton Woods, New Hampshire, in the heart of the Mount Washington area and the White Mountains! *Bring extra layers/jackets, hat, etc. to wear at the summit, the temperature will drop as we ascend!

On our way up to the White Mountains, we will stop for breakfast at Tilt'n Diner in Tilton New Hampshire to enjoy classic diner fare.

Participants will also be able to purchase snacks and food at the top of Mount Washington.

DATE: The date of this trip will be Wednesday, September 24, 2025. We will depart from the Exeter Parks and Rec Parking lot at 8:00 am and will be returning to Exeter around 6:00 pm.

FEE: The Fee is **\$105.00 for residents** and **\$130.00 for Non-Residents** that includes a round-trip ticket on the Cog Railway, Breakfast at Tilt'n Diner, and transportation in the Recreation Department Van.

DEADLINE: The deadline to register Wednesday, September 10, 2025, or once the van is sold out.

Note: Max of 12 people.

REFUNDS: No refunds after tickets/reservations have been purchased unless we can find a replacement for your spot in the program.*

*Medical Injury/Illness Policy: If there is a medically documented injury/illness we will prorate a refund after we receive written medical varication from your physician which must be received prior to the trip.

Accessibility Guidelines: The EPRD van is not wheelchair accessible. While we are able to accommodate a range of mobility levels, all participants must be able to step up into the van and step out of the van on their own without assistance. All trips will be rated for accessibility. Please refer to the top of the flyer for the accessibility rating to determine if this trip matches your level of comfort with walking, stairs, and uneven ground.
