**EVENT:** For more than 220 years, Yankee ingenuity and craftsmanship have been the keys to success for Portsmouth Naval Shipyard. In this popular tour, learn about the role and achievements of the Yard in times of war and peace from a military historian's perspective. A government-issued picture ID is required on this trip. Participants will be transported by Navy bus from Albacore Park, 569 Submarine Way, Portsmouth, NH to stops in the Shipyard. Comfortable shoes are suggested. Participants must be able to use the bus and negotiate stairs. Neither the bus nor the comfort facilities are handicapped accessible. Presenter: Joe Gluckert is the historian at Portsmouth Naval Shipyard. After our tour, we will stop at Dinnerhorn in Portsmouth for lunch on our way back to Exeter.

**<u>DATE</u>**: The date selected is Wednesday, July 9, 2025. We will depart the Exeter Recreation Center parking lot at 9:30am and will be returning to Exeter approximately 2:30pm.

**FEE:** The fee is \$30 for residents and \$45 for non-residents, which includes guided tour of Portsmouth Shipyard, lunch at the Roundabout Diner and transportation in the Recreation Department Van.

**DEADLINE:** The deadline to register is Friday, June 27, or once the van is sold out. **Note: We need a minimum of 8 people registered. Max of 12 people.** 

**<u>REFUNDS</u>**: No refunds after tickets/reservations have been purchased unless we can find a replacement for your spot in the program. \*

\*Medical Injury/Illness Policy: If there is a medically documented injury/illness we will prorate a refund after we receive written medical varication from your physician which must be received prior to the trip.

<u>GUIDELINES</u>: Registrants must sit in the same seat(s) on the return trip as they sat in on the first part of the trip. If you have a need requiring you to sit in a particular area, please let the Recreation Office know when you register for the trip. The staff will relay to the trip escort that he/she needs to be sure you get the necessary seat. **Parents** are expected to have complete control of their children at all times throughout the trip.
