**EVENT:** Visit New York during the holidays and experience the magical wonder of the big apple! We will depart from 4 Hampton Rd. in Exeter on a coach bus at 6:00am and arrive at Bryant Park right in the middle of Manhattan at approximately 10:25am. You will have 7.5 hours in the city to do as you please at your own pace! Visit the bustling shops on 5<sup>th</sup> Ave, enjoy unique culinary experiences or take in the sights such as St. Patrick's Cathedral, Times Square, Top of the Rock, the Empire State Building and more! Bryant Park, a lovely 4-acre green space, is located behind the New York Public Library and less than 1 mile from Central Park. You will have plenty of time to visit Radio City Music Hall and see a matinee of the Radio City Rockettes, do some sightseeing and have dinner before we depart Bryant Park at 6:00pm. Sit back and relax on the comfortable coach bus as we make our way back to Exeter, arriving at approximately 10:24pm. A staff member from Exeter Parks & Recreation will accompany you on the bus down and back to help make your trip more comfortable and enjoyable. *Thanks to a grant from Exeter Hospital Community Grant Funding, we are able to offer this low cost trip to adults ages 50 and over!* 

**<u>DATE</u>**: The date selected is Saturday, December 14, 2024. We will depart from the Recreation Complex located at 4 Hampton Rd in Exeter at 6:00am and will be returning to Exeter at approximately 10:25pm.

**<u>FEE:</u>** The fee is **\$60.00 for residents and \$80.00 for non-residents**, which includes round trip transportation on a coach bus with a bathroom on board. Meals and activities are not included.

**DEADLINE:** The deadline to register is Friday, December 6, 2024, or once the bus is sold out.

Note: We have a minimum of 30 and maximum of 48 spots.

**<u>REFUNDS</u>**: No refunds after tickets/reservations have been purchased unless we can find a replacement for your spot in the program. \*

\*Medical Injury/Illness Policy: If there is a medically documented injury/illness we will prorate a refund after we receive written medical varication from your physician which must be received prior to the trip.

<u>Accessibility Guidelines:</u> The coach bus is not wheelchair accessible. While we can accommodate a range of mobility levels, all participants must be able to step up onto the bus and step out of the bus on their own without assistance. All trips will be rated for accessibility. Please refer to the top of the flyer for the accessibility rating to determine if this trip matches your level of comfort with walking, stairs, and uneven ground.

Exeter Parks & Recreation Department sponsored trips are designed to provide members of the Exeter Community - families, friends, and individuals alike - with safe, relaxing and enjoyable sports and entertainment experiences. To ensure these goals, the Exeter Parks and Recreation Department has established a policy of prohibiting the possession and use of alcohol and other drugs while on board.
