

Day 1: Wednesday, November 5, 2025 Overnight Flight Your adventure begins with an overnight flight to Italy. Journey through southern Italy and experience its rich scenery, art, culture, food and wine.

Day 2: Thursday, November 6, 2025 Rome, Italy Your tour opens in the "Eternal City" of Rome! Tonight, join your fellow travelers for a welcome dinner celebrating the start of your Italian journey. (*D*)

Day 3: Friday, November 7, 2025 Rome Start your day with a locally guided walking tour of Rome's Renaissance and Baroque highlights. Climb to the top of the Spanish Steps for views of the city's skyline and down its famous 135 stairs. Stroll over cobblestone streets and weathered passageways to discover famous sights such as the Trevi Fountain and the Pantheon's imposing facade. Finish a full morning of exploration in the oval-shaped Piazza Navona, built upon the site of the ancient Stadium of Domitian. The afternoon is yours. Perhaps you'll meander through Rome's lively *Monti* district to soak in the local life. *(B)*

Day 4: Saturday, November 8, 2025 Rome Today, join an expert guide to explore the Imperial Fora. Take in views of the Colosseum's exterior, the remains of the Basilica of Maxentius, and of Trajan's Markets. Your extensive walking tour winds its way through Rome's medieval district, which developed organically from the ruins of the ancient city. This neighborhood is a charming combination of narrow cobbled streets, dark tufa stone, and repurposed Roman ruins. Make the most of a free afternoon in Italy's capital city. Perhaps you will join an optional food tour dinner and taste your way around Rome's bohemian *Trastevere* district. (*B*)

Day 5: Sunday, November 9, 2025 Rome - Pompeii - Amalfi Coast Journey to the Amalfi Coast, an iconic coastline of rocky beaches and towering cliffs. En route, pause at a local winery to savor the area's famous *Lacryma Christi* wine. Enjoy a typical lunch before experiencing the eerily preserved ruins of Pompeii your way, because **it's your choice!** Join a local guide for an in-depth tour of Pompeii's best-known monuments -**OR-** venture further afield to discover the hidden corners of this vast archeological site. In the late afternoon, settle into the Amalfi Coast,* your home for the next five nights. Before gathering for dinner, take some time to explore your hotel, perched in a scenic location above the coastline. (*B*, *L*, *D*)

Day 6: Monday, November 10, 2025 Amalfi Coast Drive** along the stunning Amalfi Coast, pausing at a panoramic viewing point for a peek at Positano, with its pastel-colored houses clinging to the cliff. Spend time in the town of Amalfi. A former trading hub, Amalfi is now a quiet coastal town of historic landmarks and a black-and-white marble cathedral. Explore on your own before boarding a ferryboat and sailing to Salerno. Return to your hotel for an evening at leisure. *(B)*

Day 7: Tuesday, November 11, 2025 Amalfi Coast Journey along the eastern cliffs of the Bay of Naples to the charming resort town of Sorrento. Wander through its narrow streets, perhaps peeking into the peaceful cloister of St. Francis or sampling some gelato made with local lemons. This afternoon, visit a traditional terraced farm and see how cheese is still made by hand. Get a taste of the product at a farm-totable dinner capped with homemade limoncello before returning to your hotel in the late evening. (*B, D*)

Day 8: Wednesday, November 12, 2025 Amalfi Coast Enjoy a day at leisure to take in the relaxing beauty of the Amalfi Coast. Perhaps you will embark on an optional ferryboat trip*** to the Mediterranean isle of Capri, where you'll enjoy lunch and a locally guided tour before setting out on your own

Although Amalfi is the coast's namesake origin, other towns along the rocky cliffs draw visitors from near and far. Find Sorrento, Positano, and more, all exuding the Amalfi vibe of winding roads, pastel-colored houses, and pebbly beaches. Travel among lemon trees and hillside groves as you make your way along the picturesque coastal drive.

The overall activity level of this tour is a level 3. This means you're an onthe-go traveler. You don't want to miss a thing, so walking and standing for longer periods of time (2-3 hours) isn't a big deal. A moderately paced twoand-a-half-hour walking tour, covering several miles, hills, and uneven surfaces, is no problem for you. Walking four miles over the course of a day is very doable, as is climbing into and out of various modes of transportation (tuk-tuk, cable car, zodiac, etc.). You can climb three flights of stairs easily, stand for extended periods of time, up to 30 minutes at a time, and handle altitudes between 6,000 and 9,000 feet. Expect some longer days with early mornings or late nights balanced with free time to recharge or set out on your own adventure. Our Client Care Agents can provide additional information or assistance to help you determine the perfect trip for you.

Travel with an average of 37 people (maximum of 44).

The archeological site of Pompeii is entirely pedestrianized, and the only access is via a steep ancient Roman street which is uphill and paved with huge, slippery cobblestones. Therefore, the site is not "accessible" by disabled standards. Throughout the archeological site, you will need to negotiate large cobblestones and steep sidewalks. There are NO vehicles inside the site, which is extremely vast. We recommend bringing comfortable, well broken-in walking shoes. You should expect large crowds at each location, with long waiting times at ferry embarkation points where there is no seating available and you will be required to queue without seating, under the sun without access to shaded areas.

The included sightseeing program in Rome, Pompeii, Sorrento, and Amalfi requires accessing locations that forbid motor coaches from circulating. The same applies for the optional tour sightseeing outlined in the itinerary. All these areas require extensive walking over cobblestones, uneven and often narrow sidewalks, and occasionally unpaved terrain with loose gravel.

If you require any special assistance while on tour, please make us aware at time of reservation so the necessary request form can be sent to your attention.

The included activities are not suitable for travelers using motorized scooters, wheelchairs, walkers or Zimmer-frames.

Days of features are interchangeable.

Most shops and businesses in Italy are closed on Sundays and on national/religious holidays.

***The optional boat trip to the isle of Capri is dependent on sea and wind conditions. According to the weather conditions, the ferry boat ride may depart from Salerno, Sorrento or Naples. The length of the sailing depends on the port of departure, varying between 30 and 120 minutes each way. Travelers prone to seasickness should take the proper precautions.

**Between November 1 and March 31, the visit of the first section of the Amalfi Drive will be operated by bus, and you will not visit Positano, which is not accessible by motorcoach. Depending on the weather, wind, and sea conditions, you will sail aboard a public ferryboat from Amalfi to Salerno. The sailing time is approximately 30 minutes. The Amalfi Coast drive is along a very narrow, winding road. Travelers prone to motion sickness and/or seasickness should take the proper precautions.

*During your stay on the Amalfi Coast standard accommodations at the Hotel Raito are limited and available on a first come, first served basis for departures utilizing that hotel. Upgrades to superior rooms with a lateral view of the coastline and garden are available at an additional cost. Some departures will be accommodated in Sorrento where the hotel does not offer coastal views. Please inquire at time of booking.

Single accommodations are limited and are available on a first-come, firstserved basis. Single rate subject to change based on availability.

To complete your tour, we <u>include</u> roundtrip airport-to-hotel transfers when purchasing our airfare with your tour. If you have arranged for your <u>own air</u>, we are pleased to provide you the option of *purchasing* these transfers. Please note that all transfers will leave at pre-scheduled times.

For air-inclusive reservations, the name provided at time of booking must match your government-issued ID that will be used during travel. Name changes are subject to penalties.



Sail past the hill towns along the Amalfi Coast, passing colorful homes, lush gardens and architectural marvels. Take the funicular up to Capri village. Here, you'll take a guided walking tour where you'll get to the picturesque hilltop botanical gardens, Giardini di Augusto. Head to one of the floral-lined terraces to see enchanting panorama views, including the spectacular Faraglioni rocks. Then, savor lunch in a local restaurant – your opportunity to enjoy a Caprese salad! Spend some free time to soak in Capri's charm. Browse elegant designer shops or sip a coffee in the Piazza and simply watch the world go by. A special ride along the funicular takes you back toward the Marina Grande to board your boat for the return to the mainland. Trastevere Food Tour

In Paestum, this triad of free-standing temples exemplifies the purity and elegance of the Doric, Ionic and Corinthian styles; remarkably preserved for over 25 centuries. Standing on an ample plain, Paestum proved in later times to be the ideal terrain for water buffalos that reached Italy from the Orient during the Dark Ages. This generous milk-producing animal is at the origin of one of Italy's staples: luscious mozzarella cheese! After your sightseeing tour, visit a local producer where you'll taste freshly made mozzarella with your lunch, before returning to the hotel in the early afternoon. *Duration: Approximately 7 hours*. You are on your way to Florence, the 'Cradle of the Renaissance.'

Day 2: Florence, Italy

Get settled into Florence for your 3-night stay. Your local host will meet you at the hotel for an orientation briefing before leading you on a neighborhood walk, providing you with dining suggestions for your evening at leisure.

Day 3: Florence

Start your morning with a locally guided walking tour of Florence's cultural treasures, passing by the Duomo, the Baptistery, the Palazzo Vecchio, and the Piazza della Signoria. Day 4: Florence

Explore Florence's bohemian *Oltrarno* district during a guided walking tour of the city's Left Bank. *Oltrarno* literally means "on the other side of the Arno," the river which runs through Florence. Grasp the spirit of this "Florence of the Florentines:" here the last craftsmen, the market stalls, the gardens and churches, the typical restaurants and cafés still move at the gentle rhythm of everyday life, away from the hustle and bustle of Florence's more famous monuments. The *Oltrarno* was so dear to the Medici family – Florence's great rulers – that they made it their home by establishing themselves in the Pitti Palace. The remainder of the day is yours to explore more of Florence. Perhaps you'll venture up to Piazzale Michelangelo, a panoramic terrace offering charming views over the city's towers and domes. *Today breakfast will be included*.

Day 5: Florence - Rome

Your Florentine sojourn comes to a close today. Say Arrivederci! as you transfer to Rome by high-speed train** to begin your tour. Today breakfast will be included.
