EVENT: Join Exeter Parks & Recreation for a day in Boston! Our first stop will be at the Edward M. Kennedy Institute, which is dedicated to educating the public about the important role of the Senate in our government. The institute's main attraction is their Senate Chamber, an exact full-scale replica of the United States Senate Chamber and the only replica of the Senate in the world! Our second stop will be next door at the Commonwealth Museum. The Commonwealth Museum brings the story to life with state-of-the-art interactive exhibits. Don't miss their "treasures gallery", which holds great historic documents that protect our liberties! Once we are done visiting the museum we will head back to NH, stopping at Red's Kitchen in Peabody, MA for lunch.

DATE: The date selected is Wednesday, February 19, 2025. We will depart the Exeter Recreation Center parking lot at 8:15am and will be returning to Exeter approximately 4:00pm.

FEE: The Fee is **\$15 for residents and \$25 for non-residents** that includes transportation in the recreation van, admission to Kennedy Institute, Commonwealth Museum, and lunch at Red's Kitchen. This trip is for adults ages 50+ only due to grant requirements.

DEADLINE: The deadline to register Wednesday, February 12, 2025 or once the van is sold out.

Note: We need a minimum of 8 people registered. Max of 12 people.

REFUNDS: No refunds after tickets/reservations have been purchased unless we can find a replacement for your spot in the program.*

*Medical Injury/Illness Policy: If there is a medically documented injury/illness we will prorate a refund after we receive written medical varication from your physician which must be received prior to the trip.
