

Portland Discovery Land & Sea Tours Wednesday, July 2, 2025



**EVENT:** Experience the iconic lighthouses and sights of Portland Harbor AND the picturesque waterway Diamond Pass. We'll explore the bustling inner harbor and main shipping channel to get close up views of civil war era forts and the lighthouses that guide mariners into Portland Harbor. This tour includes everything you see on the Lighthouse Lovers Cruise and more! Before we set sail, we will stop on our way in South Portland, ME to have lunch at Dock's Seafood Restaurant & market.

**<u>DATE</u>**: The date selected is Wednesday, July 2, 2025. We will depart the Exeter Recreation Center parking lot at 10:00am and will be returning to Exeter approximately 4:30pm.

**FEE:** The fee is \$78.50 (residents) or \$98.00 (non-residents) per person that includes lunch at Dock's Seafood, 105-minute fully narrated boat tour of Portland Harbor and transportation in the Recreation Department Van.

**DEADLINE:** The deadline to register Friday, June 27, 2025, or once the van is sold out. **Note: We need a minimum of 8 people registered. Max of 12 people.** 

**<u>REFUNDS</u>**: No refunds after tickets/reservations have been purchased unless we can find a replacement for your spot in the program.\*

\*Medical Injury/Illness Policy: If there is a medically documented injury/illness we will prorate a refund after we receive written medical varication from your physician which must be received prior to the trip.

<u>GUIDELINES</u>: Registrants must sit in the same seat(s) on the return trip as they sat in on the first part of the trip. If you have a need requiring you to sit in a particular area, please let the Recreation Office know when you register for the trip. The staff will relay to the trip escort that he/she needs to be sure you get the necessary seat. **Parents** are expected to have complete control of their children at all times throughout the trip.

Exeter Parks & Recreation Department sponsored trips are designed to provide members of the Exeter Community - families, friends, and individuals alike - with safe, relaxing and enjoyable sports and entertainment experiences.
