PROGRAM: A Coed Youth Soccer program for 2 & 3 year olds! The goal for this age group is to introduce them to fundamental soccer activities, physical development, teamwork, self-confidence, communication coordination & most importantly...Have Fun! This will be purely instructional and **parents are required to participate with their child.** All players are issued a game shirt to be worn on Saturday mornings. Cleats or sneakers to be worn. Shin guards and mouth guards are required. This 60-minute program will take place Saturdays between 8am-10am at Recreation Park.

<u>REGISTRATION</u>: Registration begins Monday, July 1st, 2024. Registration is open to residents of Exeter and surrounding towns, on a first-come, first-served basis. Registrations accepted at the Recreation Office during our business hours, on-line, by phone or in person. Payment must be paid at the time of registration. The Exeter Parks and Recreation Department reserves the right to limit registration and participation in any program. Exeter Parks & Recreation also reserves the right to effect other changes in the program, including but not limited to date and time changes, registration limits, and others, as may be required.

LOCATION: The program will be held on Saturday Mornings at Recreation Park on Hampton Road. Games are generally played between 8am and 10am.

<u>FEE</u>: The cost of this program includes a Soccer Shirt for each participant. Please make your check payable to E.P.R.D. Visa and MasterCard accepted. There will be a \$20.00 fee charged for each returned check.

<u>DEADLINE</u>: The Deadline to register for this program is **Friday**, **August 9th**, **2024 at 4:30pm**. Late registration is on a first-come, first-served basis **pending team availability**. Late Registrations will be charged an additional \$10.

<u>VOLUNTEER COACHES:</u> There is a NO FEE to coach. Coaches are necessary for the successful operation of this program. Please know that you will need to indicate on the registration as to whether you can coach. Volunteer coaches are required to complete a background check. Coaches must pre-register and complete all required paperwork. Coaches will receive a coaching gift from EPRD.

Coaches can request to be with another coach thus both of their children being placed on the team. At no time, can a coach request any other child to be on his team except for the other coach's child. There should only be 2 coaches per team but 3 coaches are acceptable. All coaches must complete a

<u>UNIFORMS</u>: The uniforms are for the students to keep at the end of season. THESE UNIFORMS ARE TO BE WORN FOR ALL THE GAMES. For your child's protection, <u>SHIN GUARDS AND MOUTH GUARDS ARE REQUIRED FOR ALL PLAYERS!</u> Cleats are highly recommended. Shin guards and mouth guards are available at most local department or sporting goods stores.

PARENTS/COACHES: For your child's safety, players may not wear jewelry of any kind or watches. Please report any injuries to the Exeter Parks & Recreation Department within 48 hours of occurrence.

<u>CONDUCT/LANGUAGE RULE:</u> Players, coaches, parents and spectators must refrain from use of any in-appropriate language and/or actions and/or gestures or other inappropriate conduct while at any EPRD program, facility, or function. This includes but is not limited to ALL YOUTH SPORT PROGRAMS. **PLEASE NOTE:** Any conduct by a parent, coach or spectator deemed inappropriate at any time during the season may result in immediate dismissal from the premises and program.
