PROGRAM: Exeter Parks and Recreation is offering a recreational basketball program for students in grades 5 & 6 and grades 7 & 8. This is not a co-ed program; we will be offering all boy teams and all-girl teams. Exeter will be participating in the Lamprey River Youth Basketball League out of Raymond, NH.

COACHES MEETING: Tuesday, December 3, 2024 at 6:30PM at Raymond High School.

<u>REGISTRATION</u>: Registration is open to students of Exeter and surrounding towns, on a first-come, first- served basis, starting on Tuesday, September 3, 2024. If you are a non-resident, please check if your local recreation department is offering basketball in the Lamprey River Youth Basketball League prior to registering with Exeter. Registrations accepted at the Recreation Office during our business hours, on-line, mail or by phone. Payment is required at the time of registration. Fee increases by \$10 on November 9, 2024.

The Exeter Parks and Recreation Department reserves the right to limit registration and participation in any program. Exeter Parks & Recreation also reserves the right to effect other changes in the program, including but not limited to date and time changes, registration limits, and others, as may be required.

LOCATION: Practices will be at Lincoln Street Gym. Games will be played in Exeter and surrounding towns in the basketball league including but not limited to Raymond, Chester, Candia, and Sanborn.

PRACTICES/GAMES: 1 Practice and 1 game per week, practices determined by coach. Games begin December 7, 2024. Practices begin November 18, 2024.

<u>PARENTS:</u> We encourage you to have the child attend all practices and games, however our leagues are recreational and therefore they are not mandatory. <u>UNIFORM RULE</u>: The participants are issued a game shirt and shorts. Students may keep their uniform at the end of the season. Court sneakers are to be worn during the program. Per school regulations please do not wear black-soled shoes, as they may mark up the floor. Mouth guards are recommended.

<u>NOTE</u>: If you are interested in volunteering for this program, please register at the Exeter Recreation office, online, or by phone. WITHOUT VOLUNTEERS WE CANNOT RUN THIS PROGRAM! Please do not sign up as a coach if you cannot make a commitment. You must commit to being present at all games and practices unless you have a co-coach that has been approved by the Department. Unfortunately we cannot guarantee you a co-coach if you register as a coach.

PARENTS/GUARDIANS: PLEASE READ ALL OF THIS REGISTRATION FORM, FRONT AND BACK.

- 1. Coaches can request to be with another coach thus both of their children being placed on the team. At no time, can a coach request any other child to be on his team except for the other coach's child. There should only be 2 coaches per team but 3 coaches are acceptable. All coaches must complete a background check to be considered.
- 2. Coaches determine the practice session day/time therefore we cannot accept day/time requests. This is a non-competitive league so practices are optional we will not issue refunds for schedule conflicts.
