

Adult Group Tennis Lessons – Ages 18+ Beginner & Advanced Clinics



CLASS DESCRIPTION: Social tennis group lessons are designed for beginner and advanced players. Whether you're a beginner keen to learn the basics or an advanced player looking to improve. Beginning players will focus on developing a solid foundation for their tennis journey by learning the fundamentals, which include good grip, footwork, and stroke methods. The teaching focuses on promoting the value of control and consistency. Our sessions focus on improving strategic gaming, honing skills already possessed by advanced players, and teaching more complex strategies like spin variations and smart court placement. Participants will get a sophisticated grasp of the game through tailored drills and feedback, which will promote their enjoyment and proficiency on the tennis court. Part of the session would be social interactive games, which are designed to improve tennis skills in a friendly social group setting where everybody will be able to find their place to feel comfortable and safe.

INSTRUCTOR: Pavel Pazourek. is a professional tennis coach with certification through USPTA. Pavel has been coaching for 15 years and has been playing tennis for over 26 years. In his coaching career, he had been working with some very influential coaches in the Rockingham region of the Town of Exeter, such as; Kyle Littlefield, Mark Milton, Michael Blaisdell, Brian Beck, and the director of Advantage Kids, Sue Vitko.
