**REGISTRATION:** Registration is open to anyone age 50 and over on a first-come, first-served basis. Registrations are accepted at the Exeter Recreation Office during our business hours, online, mail or by phone. Payment must be made at the time of registration. Late registrations are on a first-come, first-bases pending availability. Class size minimum is 5 students, maximum 25 students. Registration is required. Participants may register for individual classes or all four.

**<u>FEE</u>**: This is no fee for residents to attend this class. \$5 per class fee for non-residents to attend. This series is made possible through a grant for adult (50+) programming.

**LOCATION**: The program will be held at the Exeter Senior Center, located at 30 Court Street.
